## **Pupil Transfers September 2026**

As the Council's records show your child will be due to transfer to the next stage of education in September 2026, I am writing to inform you on 1st September 2025 the facility to make an online application opens at Apply for a school place | Worcestershire County Council.

Please note, if your child is being taught outside of their normal age group, you will not be able to apply online and should contact the Customer Contact Centre on 01905 822700 for an application form.

## **Important Information**

The Information for Parents book 2026/27 sets out all of the information you will need to know about the admission arrangements. It is **very** important that you read this information prior to completing any application. The book can be found on the Worcestershire County Council website Apply for a school place | Worcestershire County Council.

You must complete an online application to indicate which schools you would prefer your child to attend. You can name up to three schools on your application. You are strongly advised to use all three preferences to increase your chance of getting a preferred school. It is very important to consider alternative schools, as it is not always possible to meet your **first preference**.

The law allows any parent/carer that has parental responsibility for a child, (which in most cases will mean more than one parent/carer), to express preferences on an application, for the school/s they would like their child to attend. To avoid multiple applications, and delays in processing, parents/carers should agree on the preferences expressed and submit only one application. If there are persons with parental responsibility not residing at your child's address, it is your responsibility to notify and/or consult them before expressing a preference for a school.

# Not a Worcestershire Resident?

If your address is not within the County of Worcestershire you **must** make contact with your home Local Authority (LA), in order to obtain details on how to make an application. The application must be completed and returned to your home LA by the relevant closing date. A list of all the neighbouring LAs and their contact details is given in the Information for Parents Book, which you will find on the Worcestershire website Apply for a school place | Worcestershire County Council.

If you do not know which school catchment area your address falls into, you should visit Apply for a school place | Worcestershire County Council.

### How do I apply?

From 1st September 2025 onwards, parents must make their School Application online by the stated closing date (see bottom of this letter).

- You will need an email address to register, prior to making your application.
- If you do not have access to the internet or you need assistance in completing an online application, please contact the Customer Contact Centre on 01905 822700.



You may state preferences for any schools, but before doing so it is recommended that you:

- Ensure you read the admission criteria for all schools you may wish to apply for, these can be found at the website above.
- Read the Information for Parents Book and Guide, both available on the website Apply for a school place | Worcestershire County Council.
- Pay particular attention to the section which gives the area pyramids indicating feeder links.
- Arrange to visit schools, open evening dates for middle and high/secondary schools can be found in the Information for Parents Book and Guide and obtain a copy of the school prospectus.
- Consider how your child will travel to your preferred schools and whether you wish to apply for Transport Assistance. Full details can be found at <u>School and college travel | Worcestershire</u> County Council.

### How will Places be allocated?

It is essential that the completed online application indicating your preferences is completed and submitted on time. Places are allocated on the basis of applications received by the closing date.

If you do not submit an application on time, you may not be considered for places until after those that applied by the closing date. Applications received after the deadline may be classed as late and you may be refused a place, even if you live in the catchment area, have a child at the school already or live very close to the school. This year we are expecting significant pressure across the county for places in Year 7 for September 2026, particularly in Worcester City and the surrounding towns.

Please be aware that if you are unsuccessful in obtaining your preferred schools, if you have not applied on time for your catchment area/designated school as a higher preference, you will not be eligible for transport assistance to any alternative school that may be offered

School places will be allocated in accordance with the admission policy for each school.

#### How will I find out the outcome of my application?

All Worcestershire resident parents will be notified by this office of the outcome of their applications. In the case of Academy, Foundation, Free and Voluntary Aided Schools or schools in another Local Authority, the notification will be made by Worcestershire Local Authority on behalf of the Academy Trust, governing body or other Local Authority.
