Welcome to Summer Term 1! I hope you all enjoyed the break, the children have enjoyed telling us all about their time off. This half term our topic is Dinosaurs. We started our week by identifying the children's favourite dinosaurs and sharing their current knowledge with the class. The children have been very busy in our new dinosaur museum role play, they have enjoyed selling tickets, conducting guided tours of the museum and pretending to be a range of different dinosaurs! We have also begun exploring our key text for this term 'Romeosaus and Juliet Rex'. The children enjoyed learning about herbivores and carnivores and why the two different types of dinosaurs in the story did not get along!

In phonics this week we have continued to recap Level 3. We have focused on writing words and sentences that contain a range of Level 3 sounds. In maths we have been exploring the different ways we can compose numbers up to 10.
