This week the children have continued to enjoy our Dinosaur topic. After writing our letter to Terrance the T-Rex, all the children were delighted to receive a reply. Terrance has told us he is a little bit shy but is hoping to come and visit school soon when it is quiet! We have continued to explore our key text Romeosarus and Juliet Rex, it is wonderful to see the children using the knowledge they have gained from our story independently in their learning. I have seen lots of fantastic masks designed in our creative area for the herbivores masked ball! This week the children also reflected on what has happened in the story so far and with a friend, predicted what they think might happen next. We have also been busy creating dinosaur skeletons for our museum!

In maths this week the children have been busy re-capping doubling and identifying odd/even numbers. In phonics we have continued to re-cap our Level 3 learning. We had lots of fun using our phonic knowledge to help us unscramble silly sentences!
