During the day the children discussed their favourite books and story characters as a class; it was wonderful to hear about all of the different stories the children love.

This week our around the world adventure has taken us to Greece. We looked at lots of beautiful photos of different Greek islands and discussed why we thought people choose to go on holiday there. We then watched a video of some Greek dancing. The children were fascinated and loved the music so of course we had to have a go! All the children watched the video carefully and recreated the actions. During our independent learning time the children have enjoyed creating a packing list for a trip to Greece. I was very pleased to see hats, sunglasses and suncream on lots of lists!

On Wednesday afternoon the children enjoyed drawing to music. We started by listening to a few different pieces of music and exploring how they made us feel. After this the children chose one of the tracks we listened to and used the pencil crayons to express how the music made them feel. It was lovely to see lots of bright and colourful pictures as many of the children said all music makes them feel happy!

In phonics this week we have continued to consolidate our Level 3 learning with a focus on applying this knowledge when writing simple words and captions. In maths we have been measuring/comparing length and height. The children particularly enjoyed their tower building challenge and measuring the height of the tallest tower.
