Dear all,

Welcome to Autumn Term 2! I hope you all had a lovely week. The children have enjoyed sharing all the things they got up to with us in class. We have heard about lots of pumpkin carving, dressing up and trick or treating. The children have all returned to our routine brilliantly, they were very keen to remind me about P.E on Monday! This term our topic is 'Festivals'; the children will be exploring different festivals around the world and how they are celebrated. This week we have been thinking about Bonfire Night; we explored why people remember the 5th of November and talked about how to keep ourselves safe around fireworks. After this the children all created a firework picture. It was lovely to see the amazing firework designs that the children created independently.

In phonics this week we have continued to recap our Level 2 learning. The children have been segmenting and blending words to support their reading and writing. We have focused on the Level 2 tricky words and exploring strategies to help us identify them. The children enjoyed looking at the words and finding the 'tricky part' (the part we cannot hear using our sounds) and even called themselves the tricky detectives! In maths this week we have been exploring 2D shapes with a focus on circles and triangles. The children have been sorting shapes, identifying basic properties and finding 2D shapes in the environment.

Phonics Workbooks: Our learning has focused on consolidation, due to this there are no new sounds for the phonics workbooks.
