What a wonderful start to our week we had with the activity afternoon! The children enjoyed all of the different stations set up by the adults which included a dance workshop, paddling pools and a penalty shoot out! It was wonderful to see the children having so much fun with their friends from lots of different classes in the school.

This week the children have been busy writing letters. We have now come to the end of our story Clem and Crab, the children discussed ways we can encourage others to make a difference. As a class we decided to write a letter to Rufus, explaining to him why we should not drop litter. The children worked with their learning partners to create different sentences for our class letter. The next day the children then worked independently to write a letter to a person of their choice. It was wonderful to listen to the children recall the information learnt from our topic and use this knowledge to create fantastic informative sentences. On Wednesday afternoon we had a fun afternoon exploring the different seasons with a focus on summer and winter.
