We have had a wonderful last week of term in Reception. I am so impressed with the children's perseverance and determination this week. Despite the tiredness and sniffles, the children have continued to come in full of energy and festive cheer. Our week has of course included lots of festive fun. The children have been busy designing Christmas jumpers, writing Christmas cards in our workshop and making Christmas patterns on the peg boards.

On Tuesday afternoon we had lots of fun exploring how to make a map. The children recalled our local walk last week and we identified the key features of our village e.g. pub, café, park and school. The children then created their own map of Flyford Flavell using this knowledge. I was very impressed with how confidently the children recalled the features of our village, the maps they created were fantastic!

In maths this week we have explored sequencing events and identifying different times of the day. In phonics we have focused on recapping our previous learning. The children particularly enjoyed searching for 'ch' words in Mrs Bown's café menu!

**Christmas Jumper Day:** Tomorrow we are having a Christmas Jumper day at school. The children are invited to come in wearing a Christmas Jumper with their usual school (Forest School for Reception) uniform.
