### STEM Challenge

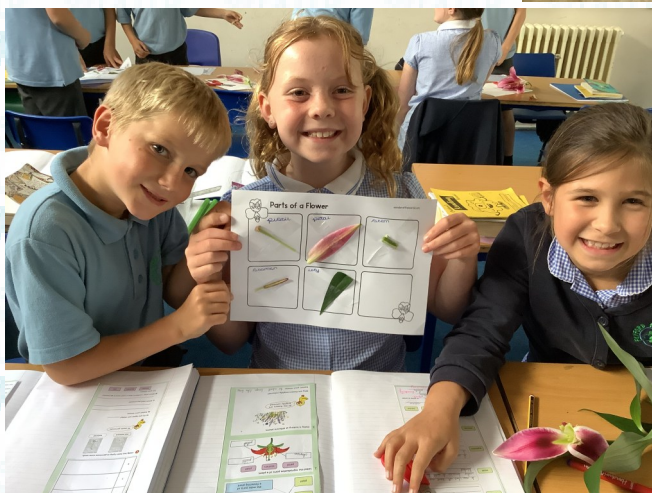
