Explore different likes and dislikes within the class

Increase independence when managing own needs e.g. washing hands and toileting

Recognise and practise a range of coping strategies when faced with certain emotions

Practise expressing feelings verbally to ensure adults can help

Recognise different ways to keep our bodies healthy (including oral hygiene)

Continue to develop fine motor skills through various independent activities

Use a variety of different tools safely e.g. scissors forks, spoons

Move with control and co-ordination
