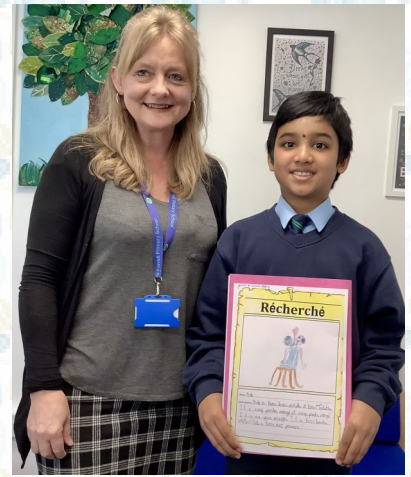
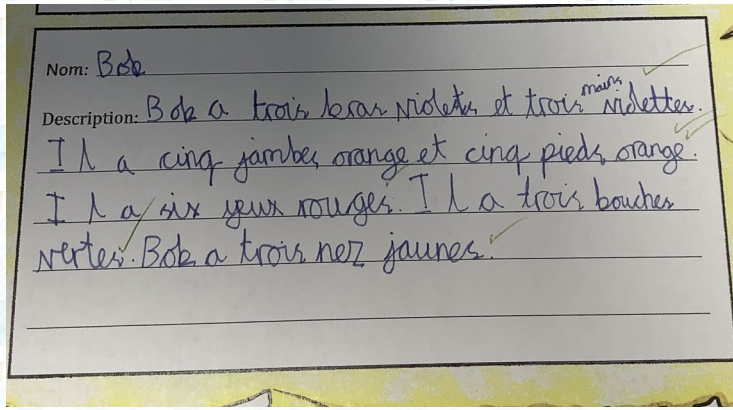
Home Learning

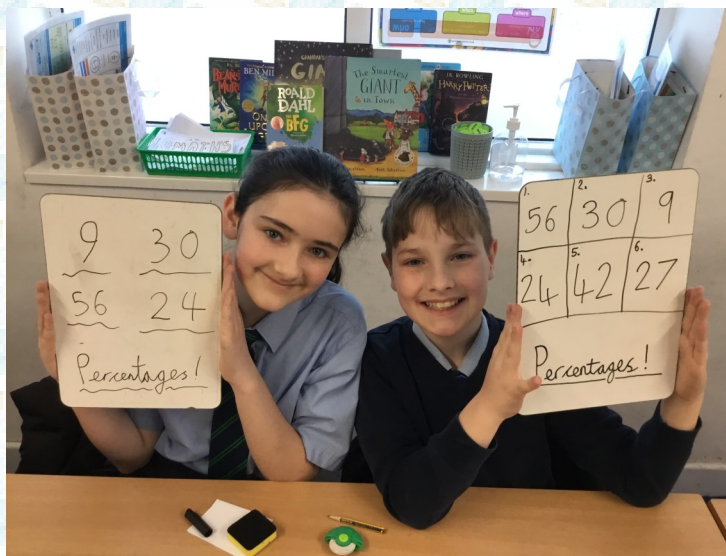


Impressive French

Super Proud

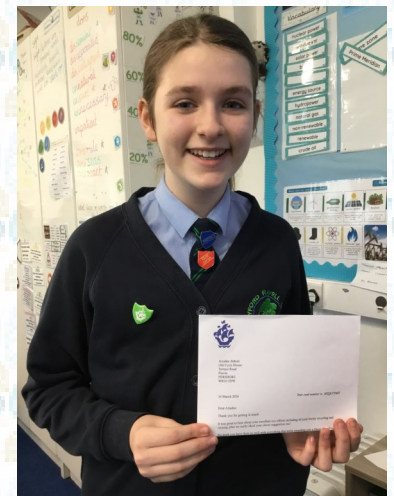
