

## History

In History this term we will be exploring the key reasons for the Anglo-Saxon invasion of Britain. We will be looking at the key features of their settlements and the changes and continuities in prehistoric Britain. We will be describing how Christianity spread through Britain and the threat the Vikings posed to the Anglo-Saxons.

## Computing

This term we will be researching and storing data using spreadsheets. We will be designing a weather station which gathers and records data and learning how to search for weather forecast information. We will create a video which includes weather forecast information.

## Music

In music, this term we will be exploring Jazz. We will be learning about ragtime style music, traditional jazz and scat singing. We will be using call and response to compose a performance and compose and play a jazz motif.

## English

This term we will be writing an information board based on the book, Amazing Rivers. A non-fiction book that will help us give information and persuade people to look after our waterways.

Our grammar and punctuation learning will be building on our knowledge of present perfect tense and consolidating our learning about possessive apostrophes and using a or an.

## Science
