

History

This term we will be guided through a whistle-stop tour of history through the lens of important historical figures.

This unit will prepare the children for the challenges of key stage 3 History. It will teach them the historical skills of inference, extracting information from sources, evaluating historical figures and the opportunity, like historians, to decide their criteria for significance.

Computing

We will learning about data and designing a 'smart school'.

We will be using our computing and information processing skills to research for, design and publish our projects.

Music

We will be introduced to Baroque and learn all about the fascinating musicians and composers who contributed to this style of music. We will use our notation knowledge to have a go at playing some music.

English

Science

In science, after completing our light unit, we will continue studying parts of the circulatory system including the heart and blood.

We will also learn about the impact of diet, drugs and exercise on heart health.
