Year 3 and 4 had a fantastic day out at Bishops Wood where they travelled back in time to become Anglo Saxons for the day.

Our children explored why Anglo Saxons chose to leave their homes and make long journeys in search of better land and resources. They thought carefully about how difficult these journeys would have been and what it might feel like to start a new life.

The children tried traditional Anglo Saxon skills, including spinning wool, making clay pots and copper amulets and designing shelters. These activities helped bring learning to life and gave pupils a real insight into daily Anglo Saxon life.

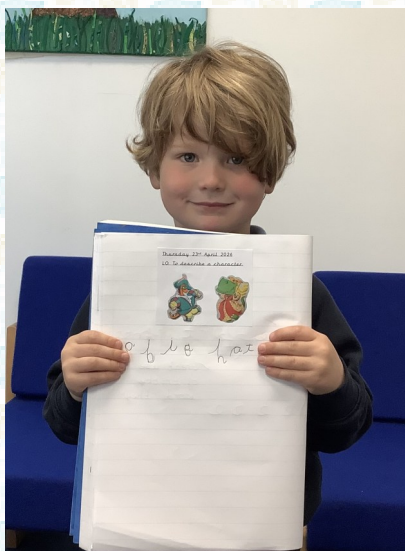
Our children had a fantastic time and we were all really grateful for the opportunity.

Super Writing !

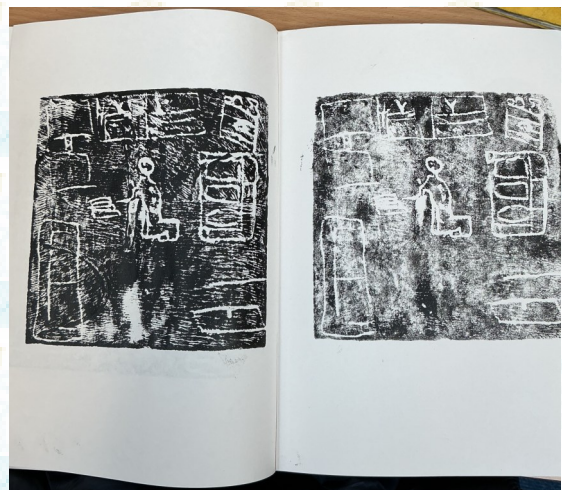
