Homework

English/Topic/Science -homework will be issued weekly on a Wednesday and will be in the children's homework books. This will be due in the following **Wednesday**.

Weekly spellings - **Fridays**. Every Friday I will issue spellings; the spelling test will be completed the following Friday. Please encourage daily revision on Edshed or in spelling books.

TT Rockstars - quick multiplication facts are key in Year 3 and 4 so frequent practice is encouraged please. Little and often practice should amount to 20 minutes or more a week. This will be checked every **Friday** to ensure each child has accessed their timestables.

Reading - Daily. Please read with your child daily for 20 minutes. There is no better way to practice reading skills, develop vocabulary and improve reading fluency.
