## History

Create a timeline based on the Anglo-Saxons and different events that occurred during the years they settled in England. On it mark the Battle of Edington, Stamford Bridge and the Battle of Hastings. Can you mark on a map where each battle took place?

## Maths

Draw different shapes and find the lines of symmetry of each.

Imagine you have £10.00. Go to your local shop or supermarket and list what you could buy. What change would you get back? What is the most amount of things you could purchase for that £10.00?

Create a questionnaire for your friends and/or family. Plot your results onto a bar graph. What questions could you ask about the information you have gathered?

## English

Write a diary entry from the perspective of Alfred the Great. Did he really mean to burn those loaves?

Create a picture book, telling a story about a journey that you have been on.

Write a poem about your favourite food. Use your senses to help you. Could you include a simile or metaphor?
