Home learning

Reading – Please ensure reading at home is completed and recorded in the reading diary daily. Consistent daily reading leads to an important improvement in fluency, speed and comprehension.

Numbots – Numbots logins can be found inside the children's reading records. Please engage in at least 5 minutes per week. Please continue to use Numbots at home to increase mathematical fluency. Numbots ceremonies for certificates will be held on Fridays!

Spellings – Spellings will be taught in school, but please practice additionally at home. Please ensure the spellings books are brought into school every Monday for our spelling tests and for new lists to be added.

EdShed – The weekly spellings lists will also be uploaded onto EdShed. EdShed is full of fun and useful games that the children can use to practice their spellings. Fuzzy and Buzzy like to see who has been logging on to practice!

Home Learning – Home learning tasks can be found on our Home Learning Web on our class website page. Tasks are due Wednesday 15th July.

Our Curriculum

This half term our theme is

What Can We See At the Coast?



History: The children will learn all about what we can see at the coast.

Science: We will be learning all about growing and cooking.

P.E: Our PE lessons will be focussed on striking/fielding and swimming. These will be carried out on Tuesdays (striking/fielding) and Thursdays (swimming). Please provide your child with suitable swimming kit on Thursdays. Please could we also ask that children keep both their indoor and outdoor P.E. kits in school. For indoor P.E., they need navy shorts and black pumps. For outdoor sessions, children may wear navy jogging bottoms and trainers. Even when outdoor P.E. is planned, poor weather may mean the lesson takes place indoors instead, so it's important that children have both of their kits in school.

ICT: The children will be having an introduction to data.

Art and DT: In our lessons, we will be exploring sculpture with clay houses!

RE: We will be discussing what we mean by a prophet.

PSHE: We will be learning about transition.

Music: We will be exploring pitch!
