### Our Curriculum

Attached to this newsletter you will find the curriculum map document for this half term. In it, you can read about all the exciting learning the children have to look forward to. We are starting our year off with a new topic: 'Exploring the Archives', where we will be using the census and other historical records to build pictures of the past.

### Autumn 1 P.E.

This year, P.E sessions will be on Monday and Thursday afternoons. The children will change for P.E in school but return home in their kits so they can be washed and brought back for the next lesson. This term we will be studying football on Mondays with Mr Kearns and gymnastics on Thursdays with Mrs Rea.

### Homework

We issue homework weekly to consolidate our learning and get us ready for the expectations of homework in secondary school.

Maths Infinity Homework - Weekly on a Monday and due in a week later. These online activities consolidate our learning in class.

English - English homework will be issued weekly on a Wednesday and will be in the children's homework books. This will be due in the following Wednesday.

Topic/Science - This homework will be issued once every two weeks and due back a week after issuing - usually on a Wednesday too.

Weekly spellings - Fridays. Every Friday I will issue spellings; the spelling test will be completed the following Friday. Please encourage daily revision on Edshed or in spelling books.

TT Rockstars - quick multiplication facts are key in year 6 so frequent practice is encouraged please. Little and often practice should amount to 15 minutes or more a week.

Reading - Daily. Please read with your child daily for 20 minutes. There is no better way to practice reading skills, develop vocabulary and improve reading fluency.
