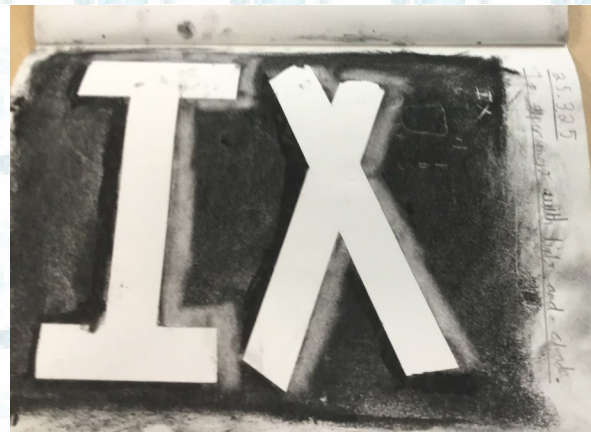

Year 1 have been designing pizzas to learn more about fractions.

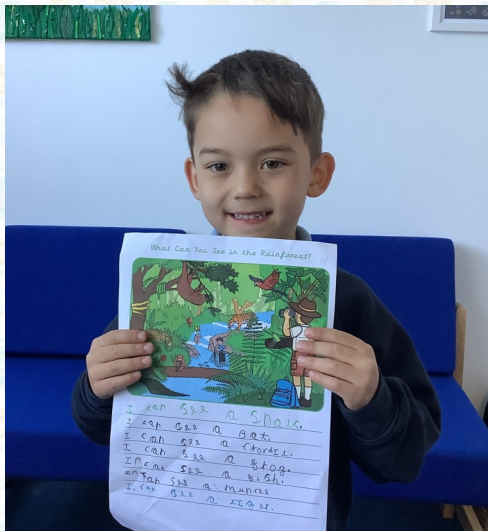
