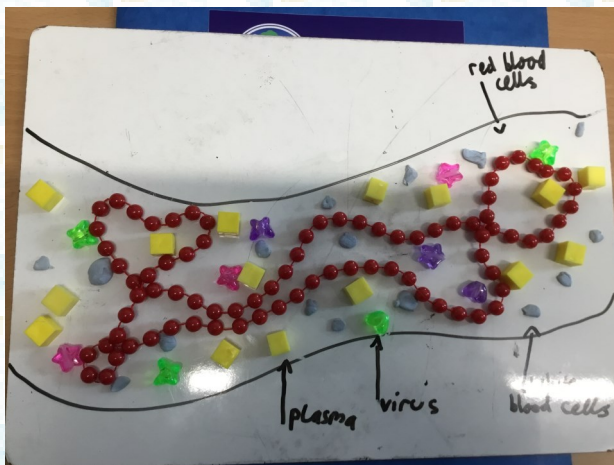


Spring Planting
